RESOLUTION REQUIRING A PERMIT BEFORE INSTALLING A DRIVEWAY CONNECTING TO A COUNTY ROAD

WHEREAS, In order to eliminate safety hazards on county roads caused by the washing of aggerate and/or debris from driveways connecting to county roads, and

WHEREAS, in order to establish a minimum standard for the construction of driveways connecting to county roads in DeKalb County; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that from this day forward all property owners desiring to install a driveway connecting to a county road in DeKalb County must first obtain a permit from the DeKalb County Highway Department located at 720 Smith Road, Smithville, Tennessee. Any new driveway entrance constructed onto property with a grade higher than the existing roadway shall be a minimum of 5ft level with the roadway measured from the edge of the existing roadway.
